| <b>Gan K</b>    | <i>BJL Beginnings Alef to Tav Activity Book</i><br><br>learn the basics of the aleph-bet, introduce students to each letter by name and sound   | Home rituals; Parashat HaShavuah; Holidays  |
| <b>Aleph 1</b>  | <i>Journeys Through the Alef-Bet Hebrew Primer</i><br><br>review the aleph-bet, introduce vowels and basic Hebrew vocabulary; begin to read, practice <i>brachot</i>  | Home rituals; Parashat HaShavuah; Holidays, discovering the people and objects in a synagogue   |
| <b>Bet 2</b>    | <i>Ot L'Baot &amp; Derech Bina</i><br><br>Students will meet Mahir, the bilingual Hebrew dog, who will help them read and guide them through basic Jewish concepts, holidays, and the Hebrew language. Students will also learn how to write in Hebrew script.                                    | <i>Jewish Values from Alef to Tav</i><br><br>Students are introduced to important values through a wonderful array of Jewish stories. They also have the opportunity to delve deeply into the weekly Torah parshah.   |
| <b>Gimmel 3</b> | <i>Journeys Through The Siddur: Friday Evening</i><br><br>Learn and master the Friday evening service while exploring Hebrew roots and themes of each prayer. Students will also have the opportunity to learn Ashrei.  | <i>Yisrael Sheli</i><br><br>Students will learn a love of Israel by exploring its history, land, and people from ancient to modern times.<br><br>Parashat HaShavuah; Holidays   |
| <b>Daled 4</b>  | <i>Journeys Through The Siddur: Saturday Morning</i><br><br>Learn and master the brachot surrounding the Shema and V'ahavta. They will also focus on the Barchu, Mi Kamoch and Kiddush. Daled students will have the opportunity to learn the Bereshit Aliyah, Torah Blessings, and Shir Hakavod. | <i>Make a Midrash Out of Me</i><br><br>Kitah Daled students will explore Jewish texts, learn about midrash, and delve into the stories of Genesis and Exodus in great detail while learning about many forms of Jewish commentary.<br><br>Parashat HaShavuah; Holidays  |
| <b>Hey 5</b>    | <i>Sfatai Tiftah Volume 2 &amp; Siddur</i><br><br>Learn and master the Amidah, Kedushah, Hallel, Shalom Aleichem and Birkat Hamazon   | <i>Eizehu Gibor: Living Jewish Values</i><br><br>Students will meet Jewish heroes and explore their character traits and central Jewish values.<br>Home rituals; Parashat HaShavuah; Holidays   |
| <b>Vav 6</b>    | <i>Journeys Through The Siddur: Torah Service and Concluding Prayers</i><br><br>Learn the Torah service, Torah and Haftorah blessings, Ein Keloheinu, Aleinu, Kadish, Adon Olam. Students will also be introduced to Haftorah trope.  | <i>Time of Our Lives</i><br><br>Learn about the Jewish life cycle, see Bar and Bat Mitzvah as one component of a Jewish life. | <b>Zayin 7</b>  | <i>Shalom Ivrit: Welcome to Modern Hebrew 3</i><br><br>Students will learn conversational Hebrew and expand their knowledge of modern Hebrew vocabulary. Students will also review tefilah and be exposed to weekday services.  | <i>A History of the Jewish People</i><br><br>Learn about Jewish history from ancient to modern times. Students will also delve into ethical issues and learn about tikkun olam and tzedakah.
