We are looking forward to the High Holiday season of 5779, which begins with Selichot on Saturday evening, September 1, 2018 at 9:00 pm. <u>This packet contains all of the information you will need for this year's High</u> <u>Holidays including a complete schedule of services.</u> (see reverse)

- Please be reminded that you will need a ticket for each member of your family who will be attending the main service (ages 12 and up) and tickets are non-transferable.
- Family members or guests who belong to other synagogues must submit a letter from their synagogue stating that they are members in good standing in order to receive reciprocal tickets to attend services at Moriah. *Due to space constraints, we will only honor reciprocity from out of state USCJ Synagogues.* Letters can be faxed to 847/948-8240.
- Moriah will continue the tradition of sending a New Year's card to each family in the congregation. The card will include an insert listing the families who choose to participate. The cost for participating is \$80. You can take part in this wonderful tradition by signing up for the first time or reviewing your listing from last year and make any edits on the order form.
- A Memorial Book honoring your loved ones will be available for all Yizkor Services beginning with Yom Kippur. Please complete the enclosed gray form carefully and list husband & wife together (i.e. Rebecca & David Cohen). A copy of last year's Memorial Book is available (via email or in the office) for you to reference your previous listing.
- Moriah now uses the Koren Machzor. Members are encouraged to purchase them for themselves, family members and guests. Additional donations are welcome to increase the shul's supply of books and can be dedicated in memory or honor of a loved one. The two-volume set (\$50) can be purchased on the order form included in this mailing.
- Sukkot begins on Sunday evening, September 23rd. Schach (\$22/bundle) will be delivered to Moriah and available for pick-up beginning on Wednesday, September 19th. Lulav and Etrog (\$55.00/set) will be available for pick-up on Thursday, September 20th, 9:00 am 4:30 pm. You can place your order for Schach/Lulav & Etrog using the enclosed payment order form.
